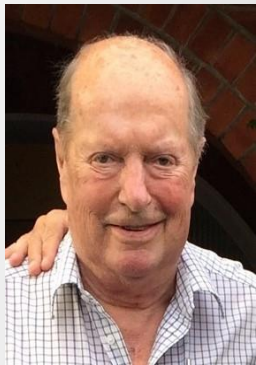
Fellowship of the Molinari Institute of Health were also awarded to Daniel Brogan and Corinne Jones.
